Pursuant to Regulation (EU) No 996/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 October 2010 on the investigation and prevention of accidents and incidents in civil aviation (hereinafter referred to as "Regulation (EU) No 996/2010"), which repeals Article 18(2) of Directive 94/56/EC, please be informed that we consider the information related to the implementation of Safety Recommendations SR-2022-A-04 and SR-2022-A-18 to be satisfactory. Safety Recommendation SR-2022-A-04 is given the status 'closed - not implemented' and Safety Recommendation SR-2022-A-18 is given the status 'closed - implemented'.

In accordance with Article 18(2) of Regulation (EU) No 996/2010, please be informed that we consider the planned actions related to the implementation of Safety Recommendations SR-2022-A-06 and SR-2022-A-07 as satisfactory. Safety Recommendations SR-2022-A-06 and SR-2022-A-07 have been given the status of 'being implemented - open'.
